Many of us call our neighborhood "Historic Floral Park" but, in fact, our neighborhood has no formal historic designation within Santa Ana or on the National Register of Historic Districts.

The Floral Park Neighborhood Association (FPNA) Board approved a committee of neighbors to be formed with the directive to research, review and report to the entire neighborhood on the feasibility of designating Floral Park as a Historic District. The committee is to review not only the process but educate our neighbors on the advantages and downsides of designating Floral Park a Historic District.

Announcements asking for Historic District committee volunteers have been made in the newsletters, e-mail blasts and at the general meetings. The committee of 20 residents has been meeting for the last two months. This committee is still open to anyone who would like to volunteer.

The FPNA Board would like you to take a moment to make sure you read the next newsletter that will be delivered to your door around August 15th. This newsletter is a very important "Special Edition Newsletter" full of detailed information on Floral Park's proposed designation as a Historic District.

In addition, two meetings have been established for neighbors to meet to discuss the process and get more facts and information. Both of these (adult only) meetings will follow identical agendas, giving you the opportunity to choose either date that works best for you.
